



Volunteer TEFL Teacher:

ICYE UK is an international youth organisation and each year we arrange placements for up to 50 international volunteers in the UK.

This February, ICYE UK will be hosting 14 new volunteers and as part of their placement we provide an On-Arrival camp, during which they will receive various forms of training to prepare them for their placements and life in the UK. As improving their English language skills is an essential aspect of this training, we are now looking for volunteer English teachers to deliver lessons at the camp.

Location:

Thriftwood Scout Campsite and Activity Centre in Brentwood, Essex. (About 50 minutes outside of London by train).

Dates:

Sunday 16th February – Sunday 23rd February - With teaching starting on the 17th of February

Summary:

Teachers should provide a fun and experiential atmosphere for students to practice their English skills and develop their competence and confidence. Where needed, teachers may also be required to provide input on grammar, etc.

We are expecting 14 young people to attend the on-arrival training this year and this group will be divided into smaller groups for the language classes to allow for different levels of pre-existing ability.

A range of teaching books and materials are available, however teachers are responsible for planning their own sessions.

Teachers will be expected to teach for 4 hours per day for 6 days. They are also welcome to take part in cultural and social activities in the afternoons and evenings.

The course is residential, and teachers are encouraged to live-in for the duration to help with providing a welcoming atmosphere for the participants.
